

Permitting agencies: county, state, federal;
CPUC, CEC

Public interest organizations; Landowners



Responsibilities

- Members represent each class of stakeholders
 - Active communication with others in class
- Adopt work plan to direct RETI work
- Expand SSC, form subgroups as needed
- Request input from, and report progress to Plenary Stakeholder Group
- Deliver consensus CREZ/transmission plans



Collaboration Ground Rules

- Facilitated meetings; minutes posted
- Transparent planning assumptions
- Good faith effort to reach consensus on key issues
 - Meeting leader clarify agreement/disagreement
 - Individual responsibility to speak up if disagree
- Work toward plan acceptable to all parties
 - Separate report by dissenting parties if necessary
