

Phase 1B Results Status Update

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- Phase 1B Report was accepted by Stakeholder Steering Committee (SSC) on December 17, 2008
- Final Phase 1B Report with changes decided upon at 12/17/2008 Stakeholder Steering Committee was posted on 1/5/2009

- Phase 1B Report is imperfect ...
- *We could* continue to refine the Report but...going forward
- Phase 2 was designed & intended to confirm, revise, & update results of Phase 1B
- Your input & our work here are part of refining process

- This is a high-level screening – not a siting process!
- Environmental Screening and Economic Assessments
- Energy Density
- Cost and Value of all known and potential (“proxy”) projects
- Grouped into 29 Competitive Renewable Energy Zones (CREZs) identified in California
- Out-of-State areas also identified

Results of Phase 1B

- The best resources are in the lower left-hand quadrant of the “bubble chart”
- These tend to be more energy dense (concentrated)
- Energy density reflected in size of the bubble
- Most new and best resources in Southern CA
- These resources include solar, wind, geothermal
- T-lines show electrical interconnections (between 2 points)

- Phase 2 Now Underway
 - Refine analysis of economic and environmental concerns
 - Members of both transmission and environmental working subgroups are here today and actively seeking your input
 - We need your help!
 - CREZs will be re-ranked and redrawn as appropriate
 - Number, size and shape of CREZs may change
 - Current maps are not final maps!
