1) Section 5.11.1 Relative Costs

The report states that Biomass "projects enjoy low capital cost from "piggybacking" on existing projects"

2) Section 5.4.5 Environmental Impacts

7-10 acres of land per MW is too much, CLFR needs 3-4 acres per MW, we recognize that other technologies may need more land and suggest that a range of 3-7 acres is more reasonable
