RE: Power Source Disclosure Program Reporting Requirements

Dear Retail Provider:

Assembly Bill 162 (Stats. 2009, ch. 313), enacted in 2009, made a number of changes to the Power Source Disclosure Program, previously authorized by Senate Bill 1305 (Stats. 1997, ch. 796, found at Pub. Utilities Code, § 398.1 et seq.). This letter updates the submission dates for all Power Source Disclosure Program reporting requirements due to these changes. If you have already fulfilled your reporting requirements independently or with the help of a municipal utility association, you may disregard this notice, as nothing further will need to be submitted for the 2009 reporting year.

One of the more significant changes is that quarterly customer disclosures are no longer required. In addition, for the 2009 reporting year, Annual Reports should be filed August 1, 2010, and Independent Audits and Annual Power Content Labels should be filed October 1, 2010. Finally, Annual Power Content Labels can now be posted directly on your website for customer disclosure. Because the new regulations have not yet been adopted to implement AB 162, the format for the 2009 Annual Power Content Label will be exactly the same as the 2008 Annual Power Content Label, with 2008 Net System Power data in the “CA Power Mix” column. Also, for the 2009 Independent Audit, you may choose to audit the Annual Report only, or both the Annual Report and Annual Power Content Label. Please refer to the table below outlining all Power Source Disclosure Program submission dates for 2009.

Energy Commission staff will be initiating the rulemaking process this summer to update the SB 1305 regulations, and will distribute the Order Instituting Rulemaking when it becomes available. During this process, staff will assess new formats for Power Content Labels that incorporate Total System Power and Unspecified Purchases values, and public input will be invited.
