



HEALDSBURG'S 2013 POWER CONTENT LABEL

The Power Content Label illustrates the type and percentage of electric generation purchased by the City and supplied to Healdsburg's electric customers during the 2013 calendar year.

Healdsburg's Electric Department owns generation plants throughout Northern California and through that ownership, almost 52% of the energy Healdsburg supplied was carbon free. These carbon free generation plants include the geothermal plants at the Geysers, the Calaveras Hydro Project, and hydroelectric power contracts with the Western Area Power Administration.
