**Subject:** TID: Ceres Police Protection Information

I spoke with Mike Borges, Deputy Police Chief with the City of Ceres Public Safety Department – Police Division. He confirmed the TID project site is located within the jurisdiction of the Ceres Police.

Mr. Borges informed me that the Ceres Police has one station, which also serves as the headquarters. It is located at 2727 Third Street Ceres, CA 95307. This is about 4.2 miles driving away from the TID site, and 2.1 miles “as the crow flies”. The Ceres Police Department has 57 full time officers.

Ceres Police has 4 levels of response, and a chart to calculate expected response time. Response time for the most serious of incidents is approximately 6-12 minutes. Response time for less serious incidents are 26-27 minutes. The project will not impact the current role of the police force.

Mutual aid response is available from the Stanislaus County Sherrif’s Department, who’s station and headquarters is at the Jail near the TID project site.

**Subject:** TID - Memorial Medical Center Information

I spoke with Steven Lilley, Director of Strategic Projects with Sutter Health, regarding information concerning the Memorial Medical Center in Modesto.

Memorial is a tertiary facility, and has a Level II trauma center. It also has a fully operational helipad. The trauma center is equipped to handle all types of industrial incidents. Serious burns would be the most likely type of situation to require transfers to other hospitals, either in the Bay Area or Sacramento.

The facility is located at 1700 Coffee Road Modesto, CA 95355. It is approximately 8 miles from the project site.

The facility has 423 beds, 362 active physicians and 2,958 staff.

The hospital is owned by Memorial Hospital Association, which is an affiliate of Sutter Health. The hospital operates as a 501(c)3 not-for-profit facility.

**Subject:** Ceres Emergency Services - Fire Division Fire Response Information

I spoke with Battalion Chief Randy Wheeler of the Ceres Emergency Services - Fire Division regarding fire response for the TID Almond Power Plant 2.

The primary Fire Station providing response will be Station #3, located at 420 East Service Road Ceres, CA 95307. The station is one of 4 operated by the Ceres Fire Division and is located 0.5 miles away (driving distance is 1.2 miles). Response time during the day has been approximated at 2-3 minutes. At night, this increases by one minutes to 2-4 minutes. Ceres Fire has 30 full-time staff.

Primary mutual aid response will come from Modesto City Fire Department and Westport Fire Protection Division. Westport is a volunteer Fire Department so Modesto City is the primary source of mutual aid.

Ceres observes all national standards and has no additional permit requirements.

**Subject:** Stanislaus County Hazardous Materials Information

I spoke with Beronia Beniamine, Sr. HMS with Stanislaus County Environmental Resources Department, Hazardous Materials Division regarding hazardous materials programs and permits.

Ms. Beniamine confirmed that the Environmental Resources Department, Hazardous Materials Division acts as the CUPA for Stanislaus County and oversees both the CUPA and related programs. These responsibilities are split between herself and the other Senior HMS officer, Robert Riess. Mr. Riess oversees both above and below ground storage tanks and the Hazardous Materials Business Plan. Ms. Beniamine oversees RMPs, Process Safety Management Plans, and the Hazardous Waste Generator Programs.

The Environmental Resources Department, Hazardous Materials Division is the primary and only department that handles these issues – there is no other “participating agency”. All inspections and permits are handled through this office.

Ms. Beniamine confirmed that no county specific ordinances or regulations exist.
