I spoke with Christine at the Chula Vista Fire Department, who gave me information on the closest Fire Station to the project site, and also how hazardous materials are handled. The closest Fire Station is Station #5, which is about 4 miles away according to Google Maps. The best guess response time to the site was 2.5-3 minutes according to Christine.

Hazardous material situations are routed through the Fire Department to the County HazMat, which alerts the HIRT (Hazardous Incident Response Team). This team can handle most ordinary hazmat situations. If needed HIRT goes through a private company to conduct hazardous material clean-ups.

She told me that the CVESD charges a fee of \$0.20 per square foot for industrial and commercial construction within the district. In regards to temporary facilities such as trailer mounted units, she said any building present at the site for an "extended period of time" would be considered a permanent structure and subject to the fee. I spoke with Nancy Plouffe of the Chula Vista Police Department. The station is located at 315 Fourth Ave in Chula Vista, CA. She informed me that 252 sworn, full time officers serve all of Chula Vista from this one station.

The police department maintains a standard for average response time to calls based on priority. Emergencies are categorized as priority one, while urgent calls are priority two. The department categorizes calls down to priority five, but does not have average response time goals for those priorities. For priority one calls, the average response time is 5 minutes 9 seconds. For priority two calls, the average response time is 10 minutes 25 seconds.
