Deputy Chief Valencia directed me to call John Berg, the fire marshal at 510-583-4912. He responded to all listed questions. "Headquarters" is equivalent to Administration in City Hall, located at: 777 B Street 94541, 4th Floor Hayward, CA. There are nine stations in the service area, with the station **nearest** to the project site located at **1401 West Winston Ave. 94545**. This is **fire station number six**. Station six has one fire engine and three fire fighters.

In case of a major structural fire stations one, two, four, and six will respond. This will total 4 engines and one truck with 16 personel including a battillion chief. All stations are in Hayward, CA.

Station one is located at: 22690 Main Street, 94541 (510) 293-8611

Station two is located at: 360 West Harder Road, 94544 (510) 293-8612

Station four is located at: 27836 Loyola Avenue, 94545 (510) 293-8614

Respose time is estimated by Fire Marshal John Berg to be between three and four minutes. Mr. Berg also mentioned that we could file a pre app., participate in "code assist", or schedule a meeting if we need help in the permitting process.

Mr. Berg did not anticipate any impacts to the Fire Department's service provision during the construction or operation of the proposed project.

John Berg, Fire Marshal, referred me to Mr. Galang as his boss, Hugh Murphy the Haz-Mat Coordinator (510-583-4924) is out of the office until Thursday. Mr. Galang answered all pertinent questions.

Hazardous Materials are handled by the Hayward Fire Department. There is no specific Haz-Mat team that responds, so the nearest responding fire station will handle hazardous material emergencies. The fire department **is** able to deal with incidences involving aqueous ammonia and metaland/or oil contaminated wastewater, the only two identified hazardous materials of concern on the project site.

Subject: Hayward PD Socio Questions

Jennifer Gomes (correct spelling) in Personnel and Training returned my last Friday's call. She stated that there are 200 sworn full-time officers in the Hayward PD and that the nearest and only station is located at 300 W. Winston Ave. Hayward, CA 94544. She re-referred me to Desi Calzada (correct spelling) in Dispatch to determine response time to a call from the site. I asked about Susan the Chief Secretary and found out that her full name is Susan Diaz and was transferred to her line.

Susan Diaz can be reached directly at 510-293-7070. I asked her the two questions regarding any foreseeable problems with continuing to provide service to their service area in light of the additional construction and long-term workers. She indicated that she could not answer those questions; and when asked who could stated that she did not think anyone at the station could as it was impossible to "foresee" problems. When I explained that no one had yet been willing to answer them and that the information was required by the CEC (and thus eventually would need to be answered in the permitting process) she indicated that it would have to be handled by counsel at a later time as it came up. She seemed to simply mean that if and when the information was required it would be handled through a more formal process.

I called for Jay Williams the Business Manager (based on a very brief conversation with the secretary yesterday), however, he was not available and I was transferred to Mike Hernandez a Business Representative. I explained that we were the Engineering Firm writing the Application for Certification for a new peaker power plant in Hayward, CA and he confirmed that Hayward was in their jurisdiction. He asked about the construction period and I gave him the proposed start and end dates of the construction as well as the peak, average monthly, and total workforce in # of persons per month and person-months respectively.

For reference the dates and numbers I gave him were:

Construction start: Nov. 2007 end: April 2009

Peak # workers: 25/mo

Average monthly: 9 workers

Total workforce: 162 person months

These numbers came from the excel spreadsheet I was sent by Fatuma Yusuf.

He requested “something” in writing. It sounded like he wanted a few more details and a printed outline of the labor requirements. I called for William Napier, the listed Northern California business representative. As he was unavailable, I spoke with Chuck Wagner the Business Agent on call. He confirmed that Hayward is in the jurisdiction of the UCB/Millwrights (they serve Alameda County) and that the projected millwright workforce the Eastshore Energy Center would require would be available. For internal reference the numbers I gave him were:

Peak # of workers: 26

Average monthly workers: ~9

Total workforce: 167 person-hours

...for a construction period beginning November 2007 and ending April 2009.

He also indicated that there members have extensive experience working on power plants, as that has been a large source of work over the last several years.
