



NOTICE OF COMMISSION HEARING ON RECONSIDERATION

EL SEGUNDO POWER REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT
APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION
DOCKET NO. 00-AFC-14

Background:

On January 19, 2005, the Energy Commission voted unanimously to reconsider its December 23, 2004 Decision in the El Segundo Redevelopment Project Application for Certification. The reconsideration, on the motion by Commissioner Geesman, is to revise the Commission Decision to include a discussion and findings supporting an override pursuant to Public Resources Code section 25525. The draft Order on Reconsideration and Errata to 2nd Revised Presiding Member's Proposed Decision were served on all parties on January 13, 2005.

The Commission's action on January 19, 2005 is limited to the Commission's procedural agreement to reconsider its Decision. Whether the Commission adopts the substance of the override discussion and findings, described above, will be the subject of a full Commission public hearing on February 2, 2005.

Intervenor Rights:

Parties and Intervenors in the proceeding may make written or oral comments upon the Commission's consideration of its possible adoption of the motion of Commissioner Geesman. Written comments can be submitted to the Energy Commission, Docket Unit (00-AFC-14), 1516 - 9th Street, Sacramento, CA 95814 on or before January 31, 2005.

The effect of the reconsideration and any action taken by the Commission on February 2, 2005, is to extend the 30-day period in which the parties may petition for reconsideration or seek judicial review of any new Decision to March 4, 2005.
