## SoCalEd taps Trina Solar to supply 45 MW of PV modules

China-based Trina Solar Ltd. said June 9 that its Trina Solar (US) Inc. subsidiary signed an agreement with [Southern California Edison Co.](#) to supply 45 MW of photovoltaic modules.

The modules will be supplied at agreed prices with deliveries taking place between the second quarter of 2010 and the first quarter of 2011. Initial shipments commenced in May, the company said in a news release.

The modules are expected to be [used](#) in SoCalEd's solar PV [program](#), the company said.

The California Public Utilities Commission authorized the [Edison International](#) subsidiary to cover up to 65 million square feet of unused Southern California commercial rooftops with 250 MW of the PV installation.

"This program is a milestone in utility-owned PV generation in the United States and Trina Solar is excited to play a significant part in supplying modules representing approximately 20 percent of the solar capacity needed for the program," Jifan Gao, chairman and CEO of Trina Solar, said in the release.
