I spoke with via phone, and then via e-mail, Vickie Brum a Planning Analyst with the Lodi Unified School district regarding enrollment and impact fees.

As of 5/30/2008 enrollment District-wide is 29, 517. At current, schools are operating "at or near capacity". Some school who are over capacity are using portable classrooms. Total enrollment in the district is expected to climb by about 6,600 students in the next 10 years and plans are in place to deal with over capacity issues.

The Lodi Unified School District charges an impact fee of \$0.47 per square foot for commercial and industrial projects.

I spoke with Joanne Augusto, Executive Administrative Assistant at Lodi Memorial Hospital (LMH). She confirmed that LMH is a primary medical facility and has an emergency room, but is not a trauma center for industrial accidents. Any major trauma would be sent to San Joaquin General Hospital in Stockton or UC Davis Medical Center in Sacramento. LMH does have a helipad to transport patients to both of those facilities.

LMH is a not-for-profit hospital and is owned by the association members. It has 180 total beds, and an estimated 20 physicians and 1100 total staff, which encompasses full and part time employees.

LMH is located 8.7 miles away from the Lodi Energy Center project site.

**Subject:** LEC - Law Enforcement Information

I spoke with John Picone, Undersheriff with the San Joaquin County Sheriff's office. He confirmed that the LEC project site is located within the county's jurisdiction. The San Joaquin County Sheriff's office has one station, the headquarters, located at 7000 S. Canlis Blvd French Camp, CA 95231. The headquarters is located 22 miles from the project site. Undersheriff Picone estimates a response time of about 20 minutes to a normal incident.

The San Joaquin County Sheriff's office has approximately 350 sworn officers. During construction and operation of the project, Undersheriff Picone would expect an increase in patrols in the area, which would not significantly impact services to the existing area.

**Subject:** LEC - Woodbridge Fire Protection District Information

I spoke with Capt. Keith Martin and Chief Mike Kirkle of the Woodbridge Fire Protection District regarding the pertinent fire response information for the Lodi Energy Center. Woodbridge has a total of four stations in its system. The first responding station to the LEC would be Woodbridge Station #4, located at 6365 W. Capitol Lodi, CA 95242. This station is located approximately 2.5 miles away from the LEC, and response time would be approximately 7-10 minutes. Any mutual aid response for major incidents would come from other Woodbridge stations, City of Lodi and City of Stockton Fire Departments, depending on situation and need.
