- I. AUTHORIZATION.** This permit is issued pursuant to Section 35780 of the Vehicle Code and does not waive applicable registration requirements or other applicable laws. Said laws must be complied with in all particulars.
- A. SCOPE.** This permit is to be strictly construed and no work other than that specifically mentioned herein is hereby authorized.
- B. LIMIT OF AUTHORIZATION.** This permit covers only moves within San Joaquin County rights-of-way under the jurisdiction of the Department of Public Works, State Division of Highways and City permits must be secured for travel over highways and streets of each respective jurisdiction.
- C. RESPONSIBILITY OF PERMITTEE.** The permittee shall be knowledgeable and in compliance with all applicable California conditions, requirements, and laws for the use of the highway system and in particular movement of extralegal vehicles and/or loads.
- D. VOID PERMITS.** This permit is null and void and hereby declared non-existent if:
1. any portion, part or section is illegible, or
 2. used before or after the times and dates indicated, or
 3. any portion, part or section has been altered or if any attempt to alter is apparent, or
 4. used to represent proper authority for carrying a load and/or moving a vehicle which is not specifically described on the face of the permit, or
 5. used to represent proper authority for carrying a load and/or moving a vehicle by any company, not specifically named on the permit, or
 6. presented without the accompaniments specifically named on the face of the permit. Accompaniments must be within the driver's reach when seat belted in the driver's seat.
- II. VERIFICATION.** The use of this permit is prima facie evidence that the driver has checked the load and/or vehicle and knows it to be within the limits as set forth hereon and has verified the routing accuracy. The vehicle and/or load authorized under this permit is subject to inspection by representatives of the Department of Transportation.
- III. PERMITEE AGREEMENT.** The moving of any conveyance or doing of any work on the highway in conjunction with the provisions of this permit shall be regarded as an acceptance by the Permittee of all terms and conditions of this permit.
- A. PERMIT SUBJECT TO INSPECTION.** The permit must be carried with the conveyance at all times while it is being moved within County right-of-way limits (California Vehicle Code (CVC), Section 35783) It shall be submitted on demand of any authorized representative of the Public Works Department or of any law enforcement officer.
- B. REVOCAION.** This permit is revocable at any time upon written notice to the mailing address of the Permittee.
- IV. REPAIR OF DAMAGE.** In accepting this permit, the permittee agrees to repair at his own expense and to the satisfaction of the Director of Public Works, any damage to rights-of-way appurtenances or structures resulting from travel under this permit. Notwithstanding, work or repair may be done by Public Works forces at the option of the Director of Public Works, the cost to be borne by the permittee. In the event of damage to County rights-of-way facilities such as bridges, traffic signals, light standards and other appurtenances, a written report must be filed with the Department within 72 hours after such damage has been done. Failure to make this report will be considered cause for cancellation of all permit privileges pending a satisfactory arrangement with the Department for repair or replacement of the damaged facility.
- V. ACCIDENT REPORTING.** Accidents occurring while operating under permit and requiring a report to the Department of Motor Vehicles under CVC Section 16000, the Department of Transportation and also the Department of Public Works
- VI. TRAFFIC SAFETY AND CONVENIENCE.** The Permittee shall at all times give strict attention to the safety and rights of the traveling public.
- C. MOVEMENT DURING DARKNESS.** Unless specifically so stated on this permit, no conveyance during hours of darkness as defined by the California Vehicle Code (and if authorized on the permit, necessary warning lights must be displayed and sufficient flagman employed so as to properly protect public traffic in all directions)


- D. HOLIDAY MOVEMENT:** Unless specifically so stated on this permit, no conveyance covered hereby shall be moved over County rights-of-way on the following holidays: New Year's Day (January 1st), Washington's Birthday (3rd Monday in February), Memorial Day (Last Monday in May), Independence Day (4th of July), Labor Day (1st Monday in September), Thanksgiving Day (4th Thursday in November), and Christmas Day (December 25th). Additional days when holiday restrictions apply and conveyance is prohibited are: the Friday following Thanksgiving Day, the immediately preceding Monday when New Year's Day, Independence Day or Christmas Day fall on a Tuesday, and the Friday after when New Year's Day, Independence Day or Christmas Day falls on a Thursday.
- E. MOVEMENT IN INCLEMENT WEATHER:** No move is to be made for the following impaired visibility circumstances except on special authorization specifically detailed on this permit:
1. In rainy or foggy weather, or when road surfaces are slick with ice, snow, frost, etc. or
 2. When horizontal visibility is less than 1,000 feet (due to smoke, dust, fog, rain, etc.), or
 3. Manufactured housing shall not move when the velocity of the wind is such that it causes the vehicle being towed to whip or swerve from side-to-side or fail to follow substantially in the path of the towing vehicle. Any accident caused by excessive wind or weather conditions shall be considered a prima facie violation of this condition.
- F. MOVEMENT IN CONVOY:** Movement in convoy shall not be permitted unless specified on the face of permit.
- G. LOAD SIGNS AND FLAGS:** All loads/vehicles over 8'-6" in width, 80 feet in length or more than 10 feet of overhang shall display warning signs. Signs shall be posted on the front and rear of the vehicle or on the front of the lead vehicle and the rear of the back trailer with multi-vehicle combinations. Signs shall have black letters on a yellow background and comply with Section 502.9 of the Department's "Transportation Permit Manual". Flags shall comply with Section 25104 of the CVC.
- H. PILOT CAR(S) AND ESCORTS:** Pilot car(s) and escorts shall be provided and maintained on County right-of-ways by the PERMITTEE at a proper distance (approximately 500 feet), in the following cases:
1. **One (1) pilot car** (preceding the load if on 2 or 3 lane road, following the load if on a 4 lane road) when:
 - i. any portion of the conveyance is twelve (12) feet in width or wider, and/or
 - ii. over routes where the vertical and/or horizontal sight-distances are restricted so that oncoming traffic does not have the conveyance in full view from a safe and reasonable distance, and/or
 - iii. any portion of the conveyance is one hundred ten (110) feet in length or longer.
 2. **Two (2) pilot cars** (one preceding the load and one following the load) when:
 - i. any portion of the conveyance is fourteen (14) feet in width or wider, and/or
 - ii. any portion of the conveyance exceeds the travel lane width measured from the centerline to the edge of pavement, and/or
 - iii. any portion of the conveyance is one hundred twenty (120) feet in length or longer.
 3. In addition to the above pilot car(s) requirements, a California Highway Patrol escort is also required when:
 - i. any portion of the conveyance is fifteen (15) feet in width or wider, and/or
 - ii. any portion of the conveyance is one hundred thirty five (135) feet in length or longer.
 - iii. any portion of the conveyance is more than seventeen (17) feet in height.
- I. BLANKET PERMITS:** Blanket permits will only be considered for moves that are no more than sixteen (16) feet in height, no more than fourteen (14) feet in width and no more than one-hundred ten (110) feet in length.
- L. PILOT CAR DRIVER:** Pilot car drivers shall be completely familiar with the rules and regulations of the California Vehicle Code and other laws pertaining to direction and guidance of traffic, and shall be fully qualified to perform the required functions.

- K. LANE RESTRICTIONS:** Pilot car(s) and/or oversize loads shall remain right of the centerline of the roadway at all times except when prevented by the physical limitations of the road. The use of a pilot car does not grant to the permittee the right to pre-empt the opposing traffic lane. When it becomes necessary because of physical limitations of the road to use a portion of the opposing traffic lane, the permit move shall not occupy that lane until it has been advised by the pilot car that the lane is clear of all on-coming traffic. Opposing traffic is not to be stopped, except in extreme emergencies. It shall be the responsibility of the permit move to stop safely and wait until the opposing lane is free of traffic before proceeding.
 - L. PROTECTION ON BRIDGES AND NARROW ROADS.** Prior to traversing bridges and roads so narrow that it is impossible to avoid extension over the centerline, flagman and other required devices shall be posted at each end of the narrow area to warn and direct approaching traffic.
 - M. PARKING ON HIGHWAY.** If it is necessary to leave a conveyance on County right-of-way at night or at times of impaired visibility, it shall be moved off the traveled way and roadway pavement so as to interfere in no way with passing traffic. Lights and other necessary warning devices shall be displayed so as to adequately warn and direct passing traffic.
- VII. PROTECTION OF ROAD RIGHT OF WAY FEATURES.** It will be the responsibility of the Permittee to check the route of travel for road closure, for other road and bridge posting, and for disadvantageous and injurious obstruction and features before sending the conveyance over any route.
- A. ASPHALT PAVEMENTS.** Conveyances with steel tires and tracks with cleats and other detrimental unevenness of road bearing surface shall not be driven over County roads without first providing a protective pad, planks or heavy bedding, under the tracks to protect the pavement unless specifically so stated on the face hereof.
 - B. BRIDGES.** This permit does not authorize crossing posted bridges with loads exceeding posted limits unless specifically mentioned on the face of this permit. The Permittee shall comply with all rules posted on bridges that are crossed. Posted limits and rules shall take precedence over any presumed authorization derived from faulty routing or out of date maps. Permittee shall assume all risks relative to these requirements.
 - C. OVERHEAD CLEARANCE.** When height of conveyance exceeds legal limit (13'6"), it becomes the responsibility of the Permittee to check all underpasses, bridges, overhead wires or other structures for impaired vertical clearance and to bypass or arrange for clearance at such locations.
 - D. TREE TRIMMING.** No trimming or damage to trees will be permitted in the course of moving a conveyance unless specifically so stated on the face hereof. If permitted, the route must be cleared by an authorized tree surgeon. (Tree surgeon's license number and statement of-responsibility must accompany application for a tree-trimming permit.)
- VIII. REDUCIBLE LOADS:** This permit is issued for the movement of an "Extralegal Load" as defined in VC. 320.5 when loaded at its least dimensions.
- IX. LIABILITY.** The Permittee, by acceptance of this permit, shall assume full responsibility for all liability for personal injury and property damage which may occur through any act or omission of the Permittee while pursuing the functions of this permit. In the event any claim is made against the County of San Joaquin or any department, official or employee thereof, through, by reason of, or in connection with any such act or omission, the Permittee shall defend, indemnify and hold them and each of them harmless of such claim.
- X. CERTIFICATION OF INSURANCE.** This permit shall not be effective for any purpose unless and until the Permittee files with the San Joaquin County Department of Public Works evidence of public liability and property damage (certification of insurance) in the form acceptable by said department for at least one million dollars. San Joaquin County shall be shown as an "Additional Insured" and "Certificate Holder" on the certificate of insurance.
- XI. TIME AND TRIP LIMITS.** Unless specifically so stated on the face hereof this permit is good for only one trip during the movement period between the points designated.

The following special conditions are applicable to all permits requiring escort by pilot car(s):

Equipment:

Failure to comply with all equipment requirements under law renders the permit void and the vehicle and/or load out of service until all necessary repairs or additional equipment are obtained to meet said requirements.

Location and Responsibility:

- 1) Single Pilot Car.
- 2) Precede on two or three-lane conventional roads.
 - a) Follow on four or more lane conventional highways, divided highways, and freeways.
 - b) When two pilot cars are required, one shall precede and one shall follow.
- 3) Pilot cars shall remain right of the centerline of the roadway at all times except when prevented by the physical limitations of the highway. The use of a pilot car does not grant to the permittee the right to pre-empt the opposing traffic lane. When it becomes necessary because of the physical limitations of the highway to use a portion of the opposing traffic lane, the permit move shall not occupy that lane until it has been advised by the pilot car that the lane is clear of all on-coming traffic. Opposing traffic is not to be stopped, except in extreme emergencies. It shall be the responsibility of the permit move to stop safely and wait until the opposing lane is free of traffic before proceeding.
- 4) Pilot cars shall maintain a safe distance from the escorted vehicle to allow both passing and warning for other traffic.
- 5) Pilot cars shall accompany the permitted load over all operational California Highway Patrol scale and inspection facilities.
- 6) At no time shall a pilot car pre-empt opposing traffic.
- 7) A pilot car shall not tow another vehicle while escorting a load unless it is specifically stated on the face of the permit or permit rider.
- 8) STOP/SLOW sign paddles shall not be displayed from the window of a moving vehicle.
- 9) Pilot cars shall not stop opposing traffic except in extreme emergencies.
- 10) Pilot cars cannot escort more than one vehicle and/or load unless specified on the face of the permit or permit rider.
- 11) When necessary to post a flagger in order to warn and direct traffic, the flagging shall be done in accordance with Title 8, Sections 1598 and 1599 of the California Division of Occupational Safety and Health construction Safety orders and Caltrans "manual of Traffic controls". Flaggers shall not be less than 18 years of age.


CITY OF LIVERMORE CONDITIONS FOR TRANSPORTATION PERMITS

Updated 2/27/2008

1. This permit is issued for movement of an "Extralegal Load" as defined in California Vehicle Code Sec. 320.5.
2. Proof of Insurance in accordance with California Vehicle Code Sec. 16500.5 may be required prior to the issuance of a transportation permit.
3. Oversize Vehicles shall be limited to routes as specified on this permit. No trucks over 80,000 lbs. shall use Arroyo Road Bridge over the Arroyo Mocho.
4. All conditions required by CalTrans and the California State Vehicle Code, Division 15, Chapters 1 through 5, shall apply to this permit.
5. If permit is an Annual Transportation Permit, the original copy of the permit must be carried in the permitted vehicle with all attachments.
6. When loads exceed the legal height limit (14'0"), it becomes the responsibility of the permit holder to check all underpasses, bridges, overhead wires, or other structures for impaired vertical clearance and to bypass or arrange clearance at such locations. Listed below are some height clearances at bridges: Livermore Ave. at RR crossing = 15', Murrieta Ave. at RR crossing = 15', and N. Livermore Ave. at I-580 = 15'1".
7. No moves shall be made Monday through Friday between the hours of 7 - 9 a.m. and 4 - 6 p.m. No moves shall be initiated which cannot be reasonably completed before 7 a.m. or 4 p.m. respectively, Monday through Friday. Additionally no southbound moves shall be made on Vasco Road between 6-7 a.m. and no northbound moves shall be made on Vasco Road between 3-4 p.m. , Monday through Friday.
8. Livermore Police must be notified 24 hours prior to the move. (925) 371-4900.
9. Special services required by unusually large or heavy loads needing engineering investigations or other services, will be billed separately.
10. The cost of all services rendered by the Livermore Police Department as a result of any omissions or commissions on the part of the permit holder during a move shall be borne by that permit holder.
11. This permit is void under the following conditions:
 - a. if any portion, part or section is illegible.
 - b. if it is not signed by an authorized representative of the City of Livermore.
 - c. if any portion, part or section has been altered or if an attempt to alter is apparent.
 - d. if it is presented without the attachments affixed that are specifically named and required upon the face of the permit.
12. Permits applied for and obtained via facsimile must be legible. Legibility is the responsibility of the applicant.
13. No permit will be issued without receipt of the approved permit fee.
14. Verification: The use of this permit is prima facie evidence that the driver has checked the load and/or vehicle and knows it to be within the limits as set forth hereon and has verified the routing accuracy. The vehicle and/or load authorized under this permit is subject to inspection by representatives of the Livermore Police Department.
15. Warning Signs and Flags: All loads/vehicles over 8'-6" in width, 80 feet in length or more than 10 feet of overhang shall display warning signs. Signs shall be posted on the front and rear of the vehicle or on the front of the lead vehicle and the rear of the back trailer with multi-vehicle combinations. Signs shall have black letters on a yellow background and comply with Section 502.9 of the State of California, Department of Transportation "Transportation Permit Manual". Flags shall comply with Section 25104 of the CVC.

OVERSIZE LOAD PERMITS

1. Acceptance of Permit: By accepting this permit, the Permittee understands that the conveyance of oversize loads or work performed on streets within the City of Pleasanton, shall be regarded as a formal acceptance of all terms and conditions stated on said permit. Written application must be submitted before permit may be granted. It is the responsibility of the applicant to accurately complete and sign the application.
2. Notification of Police Department: All oversize load applicants must notify the Pleasanton Police Department's on-duty watch commander or field supervisor 24 hours in advance of any oversize haul through Pleasanton at (925) 931-5100. If the police department is not notified 24 hours in advance of an oversize haul and the vehicle is stopped by the police, a citation will be issued if the vehicle operator does not have the permit with the vehicle.
3. Permit Subject to Inspection: A copy of the permit must accompany the oversize load within the City of Pleasanton right-of-way limits. It must be presented upon request for inspection by an authorized representative of the Public Works Department or Pleasanton Police Department.
4. Revocable: This permit is revocable at any time upon written notification to the mailing address of the Permittee by certified mail.
5. Trip Limits: This permit may be used by any vehicle operated by the permittee to move oversize loads. This permit is limited to the specified truck route and load type outlined on the permit. Any other route will require a separate permit. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in revocation of the permit.
6. Damage Repair: In accepting this permit, the Permittee agrees to repair, at its own expense and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer, any damage to public improvements within the public right-of-way. At the option of the City Engineer, repair work may be completed by the City of Pleasanton. In this case, the cost of repairs shall be paid by the Permittee within 30 calendar days.
7. Liability: The Permittee, by acceptance of this permit, shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless, the City (including its elected officials, officers, agents and employees) from and against any and all claims (including all litigation, demands, damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses, and including court costs and attorney's fees) arising from actions, or failure to act, under of this permit.
8. Certificate of Insurance: This permit shall not be effective for any purpose until the Permittee files with the City of Pleasanton Department of Public Works, evidence of automobile liability insurance with bodily injury coverage and property damage coverage (or equivalent general liability insurance) and workers compensation insurance with reasonable coverage limits which are satisfactory to the City Attorney. Such insurance shall be maintained for the duration of the permit.

9. Permittee shall comply with any and all applicable conditions required by CALTRANS, the California State Vehicle Code, and the following:

- A. Permittee shall check all underpasses, bridges, overhead wires, traffic signals, or other structures for impaired vehicle clearance and to bypass or arrange clearance at such locations.
- B. Permittee shall have appropriate warning signs on truck and pilot cars. Signs shall be posted on front and rear and shall read "LONG LOAD" or "OVERSIZE".
- C. Permittee shall provide independent pilot vehicle at the front and rear of load equipped with flashing yellow lights and appropriate warning signs (load width 12' or greater, load overhand 25' or greater, or total length longer than 120'). A pilot car may be required for smaller loads as determined by the engineer.
- D. Permittee shall provide written route survey for loads with a height greater than 16'. Route survey may be required for shorter loads as determined by the engineer.
- E. Permittee shall arrange to have CHP or Pleasanton Police escort, at its own expense, for loads with heights greater than 16'. Depending on route and/or clearances CHP or Pleasanton Police escort may be required for smaller loads.
- F. Permittee shall provide an appropriate number of flagmen and adequate traffic control measures for any interruption to normal traffic flow. Permittee shall not block traffic without an approved traffic control plan.
- G. This permit is issued for load transport only, and no storage or equipment assembly on public streets will be permitted.
- H. Permittee will not be permitted to operate during the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., or 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Additional time restrictions may apply depending on route/load.
- I. Permittee shall secure all necessary permits needed for use of overcrossings from CALTRANS.
- J. Permittee shall comply with all conditions of Chapter 13.04 Encroachment, including but not limited to, Section 13.04.230 Liability, 13.04.240 Public Safety and Section 13.04.250 Maintaining Traffic, which are not in conflict with the above specific conditions.
