# Oakley Generating Station (Formerly Contra Costa) Power Plant Licensing Case

Notice of Proposed Power Plant (Docket No. 09-AFC-4)

## Proposed Location

The facility is proposed for a 21.95-acre site within a larger 210-acre parcel in the City of Oakley, Contra Costa County, located at 6000 Bridgehead Road, to the northeast of the intersection of State Highways 4 and 160. The site is designated as Utility Energy under the City of Oakley's General Plan. It is bounded to the west by the Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) Antioch Terminal, a large natural gas transmission hub, to the north by the DuPont industrial zoned property, to the east by DuPont's titanium dioxide landfill area, and to the south by the Atchison, Topeka, and Santa Fe Railroad.

## Public Site Visit and Informational Hearing

The Energy Commission has designated a Committee of two commissioners to conduct proceedings on the AFC. You are invited to join the Committee on a bus tour to the proposed site and attend an informational hearing & scoping meeting. At this event, the applicant will describe the project. The Energy Commission will explain the energy facility licensing process and ways to become an effective public participant. The presentations will be followed by an opportunity for the public to offer comments and concerns about the proposal, as well as identify potential environmental impacts for consideration by the Commission. The public is encouraged to attend to learn about the project, the process, involvement opportunities and provide comments.
