On August 24, 2001, the Otay Mesa Generating Company, LLC submitted a Petition to transfer ownership of the Otay Mesa Generating Company, LLC from PG&E Generating to the Calpine Corporation. The Petition was filed in accordance with section 1769(b) of the Energy Commission's regulations [Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769(b)].

COMMISSION FINDINGS

The Energy Commission finds that the Otay Mesa Generating Company, LLC, Petition satisfies the requirements of section 1769(b). The Otay Mesa Generating Company, LLC, is an affiliate of Calpine Corporation. Otay Mesa Generating Company, LLC, will be responsible for compliance with the Commission's conditions of certification, and Jacob M. Rudisill, Senior Vice President of Otay Mesa Generating Company, LLC, has filed the required verified statements that they understand the conditions of certification and agree to comply with those conditions.

ORDER

The Energy Commission hereby approves the ownership transfer of the Otay Mesa Generating Company, LLC from PG&E Generating to the Calpine Corporation, effective on the date of closing.
