

**GREENACTION PROTEST OF CALIFORNIANS FOR RENEWABLE ENERGY, INC. (CARE)
MOTION TO COMPEL**

Greenaction for Health and Environmental Justice provides the following response to CARE's **First Set of Data Requests of Californian for Renewable Energy, inc. (CARE) On Greenaction For Health & Environmental Justice** received and docketed by the State of California Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission on May 20, 2005.

We apologize to the Commission for taking until today to respond to CARE's Data Request. Greenaction was unaware of the request until we received the **04-AFC-1 Motion to Compel Data responses from Green Action** on June 16, 2005. We have since downloaded and studied the referenced documents and provide the following responses:

- 1) Greenaction asserts that it is under no obligation to respond to CARE's data request (under Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1716) for documents related to environmental grants received by Greenaction from the City and County of San Francisco for the following reasons: 1) Greenaction is not an applicant in the proceedings so the only appropriate time for CARE to delve into Greenaction's background and relationship with the City is during expert testimony and for the sole purpose of determining whether we are qualified to assume that role and; 2) the requested materials are not relevant to the above referenced proceeding.
- 2) All the information requested by CARE is part of the public record and freely available from San Francisco Department of the Environment (SFE). I spoke to Sraddha Mehta at SFE and she reported to me that CARE made a request for the information on May 6, 2005 and then failed to return to review the requested documents as requested in her May 12, 2005 email to CARE. It is clear to us that CARE is aware that all the documents are available for viewing by CARE without cost. CARE's request appears to be an effort to harass Greenaction for unknown benefit.

Greenaction is deeply disturbed that we did not receive hard copy service on this important issue from CARE. We request the Commission require that CARE, from this point forward, provide hard copies of all of all requests, motions, and responses in this proceeding to all interveners and interested parties, and have them delivered via U.S. Postal Service.

Greenaction is aware of its obligation to provide responses to data requests from other parties and reiterates its apology to the Commission that it has not done so in this case.
