To all parties on the e-mail service list for R.04-04-003 QF Issues & R.04-04-025 AC OIR:

Based on discussions during the last prehearing conference in this proceeding and recent discussions we have had with a number of parties, we have attempted to create a fair allocation of the 13 days of scheduled hearing time based on the approximate pages of testimony by the parties.

(We have removed Los Angeles County's testimony and the corresponding portions of SCE, PG&E and SDG&E's rebuttal testimony from the page counts.)

The approximate page counts are as follows:

approximately 44% of the pages of testimony were submitted by SCE, PG&E and SDG&E (the Utilities);

approximately 41% of the pages of testimony were submitted by CCC, CAC/EPUC, IEP and Renewables Coalition (the QFs); and approximately 15% of the pages of testimony were submitted by TURN, DRA, CARE, CAISO and MID (the Others).

Based on these percentages, we have allocated the cross-examination Time for each of the party groups as follows:

Utilities: $44\% \times 13 \text{ days} = 5.7 \text{ days}$ that utility witnesses should be on the stand;

QFs: $41\% \times 13 \text{ days} = 5.3 \text{ days}$ the QF witnesses should be on the stand;

Others: $15\% \times 13 \text{ days} = 2.0 \text{ days}$ the other witnesses should be on the stand.

Following is a very rough straw-man witness schedule based on the foregoing allocation. We hope that it will assist our discussion during tomorrow's prehearing conference.
