BACKGROUND


Discussions during the site visit suggested that the mobile home on Clay East Road might be moved. If this were to occur, the noise analysis should be revised to describe potential impacts at the more distant residences.

DATA REQUEST

219. Please state whether the mobile home on Clay East Road will be relocated,. If the mobile home will be relocated, please identify when and where it will be located to and under what circumstances.

Response: The trailer (R1) located on Clay East Road will be relocated. Evidence of an agreement between SMUD and the property owner is included as Attachment NO-219.




FIGURE 8.5-2R3

The schedule for relocating the trailer has not been set; however, its relocation will be completed prior to the completion of construction on the CPP plant. The trailer will be relocated to other property located by Mr. Loretz, to the west of it's current site. The new location of trailer is shown as R1 on the attached Figure 8.5-2R3, which replaces Figure 8.5-2R2 that was included in AFC Supplement C.
