Dear Mr. Welch:

This letter is to advise you that the City of Vacaville is willing to provide water service to the proposed CPV Vaca Station located in the City. This service will be based on the Effluent and Potable Water Services Agreement approved by the City Council of Vacaville on July 8, 2008 (the "Agreement"). Under the Agreement, the City is reserving 5 million gallons per day of effluent from the Easterly Waste Water Treatment Plant, and up to 840 gallons per day of potable water from existing wells located at the Treatment Plant. The City's willingness to provide the water service is subject to the conditions specified in the Agreement.

In the event that ownership of the project is transferred, the City is willing to continue water service to subsequent owners of the project subject to the consent requirements contained in the Agreement. The City looks forward to working with you to bring this project to fruition.
