The structure is located in the City of Vernon, the first "exclusively industrial" city in America. The building is industrial in style, in keeping with the character of the city as a whole. Research of available Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps indicates that prior to its current use, the structure was originally built and used by the Aero Alloys & Parts Manufacturing Company.

The integrity of this property is low. Additionally, It is not a particularly good example of the architectural style or of a method of construction. Research of available historical records has not uncovered any significant associations of the occupants.
