The structure is located in Huntington Park, adjacent to the City of Vernon, the first "exclusively industrial" city in America. The building is industrial in style, in keeping with the character of the area as a whole. Currently the structure is vacant.

The integrity of this property is low as it appears that the façade has undergone remodeling at sometime in the recent past. Additionally, it is not a particularly good example of the architectural style or of a method of construction. Research of available historical records has not uncovered any significant associations of the occupants.
