***P3a. Description** (Describe resource and its major elements. Include design, materials, condition, alterations, size, setting, and boundaries)

The structure is a cross-gabled, asphalt shingle, multi-family dwelling (duplex) in a residential area. Architecturally, it is non-descript, and engenders the mass home building of post-Second World War era. Shed style roofs overhang the front porch, each supported by a single 4 x 4 post anchored in the concrete slab porch. Windows are symmetrical one-over-one, double hung sash, and are barred. The side entrance door is shaded by a bracketed shed roof protruding from the exterior wall. The exterior walls are stucco over wood. The structure is in good condition.

The setting is small scale single- and multi-family residential. The duplex fronts on both Randolph Street and Plaska Ave. and is surrounded by other residential structures. The Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way runs parallel to Randolph Street, above-grade, immediately across from the house.
