***P3a. Description** (Describe resource and its major elements. Include design, materials, condition, alterations, size, setting, and boundaries)

The structure is a residential, multi-family dwelling, that is a common architectural design in southern California from the post-Second World War period through the 1950s. The roof is partially flat, sloped and gabled with asphalt shingle material covering the roof structure. The structure's exterior walls are textured in rough stucco over wood, windows are non-distinct, aluminum-framed sliders with a wooden lintel and sash. The entry way is shaded by a sloped shed-style roof, supported by twin 4 x 4 poles. A balustrade of sorts is connected between the 4 x 4 post and the wall of the house. The structure is in good to excellent condition.

The setting is small scale single- and multi-family residential. The multi-family structure fronts on both Randolph Street and Newell Street and is surrounded by other residential structures. The Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way runs parallel to Randolph Street, above-grade, immediately across from the house.
