

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 20, California Code of Regulations, Section 1709(d), Inland Energy, Inc., on behalf of the City of Victorville, hereby submits a document titled "Application for Certification, Volume III, Data Adequacy Supplement" to complete the Application for Certification of the Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project. Seventy-five (75) paper copies and 50 copies in CD-ROM format of the document accompany this letter.

The Data Adequacy Supplement provides additional information in the areas of Transmission System Engineering, Air Quality, Land Use, Traffic and Transportation, Visual Resources, and Water Resources.
