Silicon Valley Power (SVP) is the municipal utility of the City of Santa Clara, California and will be seeking approval from the California Energy Commission (CEC) to construct and operate the Pico Power Project in the City of Santa Clara, in Santa Clara County. Foster Wheeler Environmental Corporation is assisting Silicon Valley Power in preparing the environmental assessment for the CEC filing of this project.

The proposed Pico Power Project will be a 120-megawatt (MW), combined-cycle, natural gas-fired power plant facility located in an industrial corridor that lies immediately south of Bayshore Freeway (US 101) and west of the northern end of the San Jose International Airport. The project site is currently served by a recycled water supply pipeline and is adjacent to the Kifer Substation, so it would not be necessary to construct addition transmission lines. SPV would construct a 1.9-mile linear natural gas supply pipeline from the proposed project site, north, to SVP's existing Gianara trunk line.








PICO POWER PLANT AND NATURAL GAS PIPELINE LOCATION

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

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

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
