Professional Background

Ms. Bunse's experience at JRP encompasses many elements of cultural resources management and general historical research areas including: AFCs, cultural resource management, land use, toxics, and water resource issues, as well as litigation and expert witness testimony. As a Partner with JRP she has served as a consulting historian, primary investigator, and staff manager, as well as continuing work in general research. Her seventeen years of experience includes various cultural resources management projects, extensive field recordation of historic properties throughout the state of California and other western states. She has worked with VTA staff on various projects and has authored and contributed to numerous technical reports and compliance documents such as historic survey reports for both Section 106 of NEPA, and CEQA compliance, as well as local ordinances.
