State Energy Efficient Appliance Rebate Program Guidelines

At its July 28, 2010, Business Meeting, the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) adopted changes to the *California State Energy Efficient Appliance Rebate Program Guidelines (Guidelines)*. The *Guidelines* were revised to include additional categories of eligible residential appliances consistent with the goals and policies of the State Energy Efficient Appliance Rebate Program. The adopted *Guidelines* include errata presented by staff at the Business Meeting and accepted by the Energy Commission. These errata are shown below in **gray highlight** relative to the revisions proposed in the Energy Commission's July 13, 2010 Notice.
