The PERFORM 2005 Version 2005 computer program for demonstrating compliance with the building energy efficiency standards for nonresidential buildings, high-rise residential buildings and hotels and motels is now available from the Energy Commission's publication unit. This computer program was approved by the Energy Commission as an Alternative Calculation Method (ACM) in September of 2005.

This computer program requires the following hardware and software:

- A computer running the Windows NT/2000/XP™ or Windows 95/98/Me™ operating system and a Pentium processor with at least 128 MB RAM.
- One 1.44 MB (3.5") floppy disk drive and a CD-ROM drive.
- A hard drive with at least 30 MB of free space for the installed program files and an additional 20 MB free for temporary files that DOE 2.1E creates.

The program is available as a computer CD-ROM disk and comes with a User's Guide as a PDF file on the CD-ROM. The CD-ROM is available for \$250. Please send request and check or money order made out to the California Energy Commission to:
