**Notice of Availability – Documents for the
2008 Energy Efficiency Standards for Residential and Nonresidential Buildings**

The California Energy Commission develops Building Energy Efficiency Standards (Standards) to provide Californians with an adequate, reasonably-priced, and environmentally-sound supply of energy. Standards implementation enhances California's energy policy that identifies energy efficiency as the resource of first choice in meeting the state's energy need.

The Standards become effective January 1, 2010. The Standards for residential and nonresidential buildings were developed in response to a legislative mandate to reduce California's energy consumption. Periodic updates allow consideration and possible incorporation of new energy efficiency technologies and methods.

The following documents are required for compliance and enforcement of the new Standards which supersede the 2005 Standards:
