**APPROVAL BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF
ENERGYPRO VERSION 6.5 RESIDENTIAL COMPLIANCE SOFTWARE**

The Executive Director hereby approves EnergyPro 6.5 as an alternative calculation method for demonstrating performance compliance with the residential provisions of the 2013 Building Energy Efficiency Standards, California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 6, and associated administrative regulations in Part 1, Chapter 10 (Standards).

Public Resources Code sections 25000 et seq., 25402.1, subd. (b), require the Energy Commission to, among other things, establish a process for certifying calculation methods for demonstrating compliance with its Building Energy Efficiency Standards.

EnergyPro 6.5 integrates the revised compliance manager approved by the Energy Commission on February 23, 2015, as part of the Application Programming Interface in the 2013 Public Domain California Building Energy Code Compliance - Residential (CBECC-Res) software, Version 3c. The update incorporates:

- Quick Simulation, a tool that allows a quicker simulation, not for compliance;
- Unventilated attics;
- "Check Report Generator Access," a feature to determine if the computer has internet access to the website for creating a CF1R;
- Modifications to alterations and existing plus addition plus alteration compliance to more closely match Standards Section 150.2;
- Corrections to CAHP calculation results; and
- Corrections to miscellaneous CF1R reporting issues.
