## STATEMENT OF MAILING OF

NOTICE OF HEARING FOR POSSIBLE ADOPTION OF  
PROPOSED CHANGES TO PROPOSED REVISIONS

to the

CALIFORNIA BUILDING EFFICIENCY STANDARDS  
CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 24, PARTS 1 and 6  
NONRESIDENTIAL ACCEPTANCE TESTING CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS  
ENERGY COMMISSION DOCKET NUMBER 12-BSTD-2

Pursuant to Government Code section 11346.8, subd. (c), 1 Cal. Code Regs., section 44, subd. (b), and Government Code section 11104.5, subd. (a), at least 15 days before the Energy Commission adopted the proposed Nonresidential Acceptance Testing Certification Requirements in the 2013 revisions to the California Building Efficiency Standards, Title 24 of the California Code of Regulations, Parts 1 and 6, the Energy Commission provided notice of the proposed changes to these regulations from that which were originally proposed, in the form of a *Notice of Hearing for Possible Adoption of 2013 Building Energy Efficiency Standards Amendments Regarding Nonresidential Acceptance Testing Certification Availability of 15-Day Language and Opportunity for Comment*, via email to the Energy Commission's "Efficiency" and "Building Standards" electronic mail list-servers on November 26, 2012, and by U.S. postal mail to six mailing lists numbers 50, 52, 53, 480, and 7434. These list-servers and mailing lists provide notice to persons, agencies, companies, and organizations that have expressed interest in the building standards rulemaking process.

This notice and the text of the proposed changes to these regulations from that which were originally proposed were made available at the Energy Commission and posted on the Energy Commission's website on November 26, 2012. The comment period commenced on November 27, 2012, and ran until December 12, 2012.

These list-servers and mailing lists were intended to provide notice to the following persons:

- (1) *Every person who testified at the public hearings held on October 1, 2012, on the originally proposed regulations;*
- (2) *All persons who submitted written comments at that public hearing;*
- (3) *All persons whose comments related to these regulations were received by the Energy Commission during the 45-day public comment period; and*
- (4) *All persons who requested notification from the Energy Commission of the availability of such changes.*

All interested persons were directed to the Energy Commission's Dockets Unit or to me for additional information. To my knowledge, no persons objected to this form of notice. This was done in the manner

normally and consistently used by the Energy Commission, including for the comprehensive 2013 revisions to the California Building Energy Efficiency Standards adopted in May 2012.
