The California Energy Commission proposes to adopt changes to the Building Energy Efficiency Standards contained in the California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 24, Part 6 (also known as the California Energy Code) and associated administrative regulations in Part 1. The proposed amended standards are called the "2013 Building Energy Efficiency Standards" and will go into effect in 2014.

The Energy Commission has prepared a Notice of Proposed Action (NOPA) and an Initial Statement of Reasons (ISOR) regarding the need for the proposed revisions. The Energy Commission has also published the Express Terms (45-Day Language) of the proposed amendment language.
