STATEMENT OF MAILING OF
NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION
2013 REVISIONS
to the
CALIFORNIA BUILDING EFFICIENCY STANDARDS
and
GREEN BUILDING CODE
CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 24, PARTS 1, 6 and 11
ENERGY COMMISSION DOCKET NUMBER 12-BSTD-1

A. Pursuant to Government Code section 11346.4, subd. (a), 1 Cal. Code Regs., section 86, and Government Code section 11104.5, subd. (a), at least 45 days before the close of the public comment period on the adoption of the proposed 2013 revisions to the California Building Efficiency Standards and the Green Building Code, Title 24 of the California Code of Regulations, Parts 1, 6, and 11, the Energy Commission provided notice of this proposed action to the following persons in the manner indicated:

- (1) *Every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory actions with this agency;*

No one requested written notice, however this notice was provided via email to the efficiency and building standards list serve which consists of all those who have expressed an interest in Energy Commission actions related to these regulations. This notice directs readers to the Commission website which affords the opportunity to subscribe to the Commission list serve.

The notice was also posted on the Energy Commission's website on February 15, 2012

- (2) *The Secretary of the Resources Agency;*

This notice was provided via email on April 6, 2012

- (3) *A representative number of small business enterprises or their representatives that are likely to be affected by the proposed action; and*

This notice was provided via email to the efficiency and building standards list serve which consists of many small businesses that have expressed an interest in Energy Commission actions related to these regulations.

The notice was also posted on the Energy Commission's website on February 15, 2012

- (4) *All persons and groups of persons whom this agency believes to be interested in this proposed action.*

This notice was provided via email to the efficiency and building standards list-servers on February 24, 2012, which consists of all those who have expressed an interest in Energy Commission actions related to these regulations.

The notice was also posted on the Energy Commission's website on February 15, 2012. This was done in the manner normally and consistently used by the Energy Commission.

B. Pursuant to Government Code section 11346.8, subd. (c), 1 Cal. Code Regs., section 44, subd. (b), and Government Code section 11104.5, subd. (a), at least 15 days before the Energy Commission adopted the 2013 revisions to the California Building Efficiency Standards and the Green Building Code, Title 24 of the California Code of Regulations, Parts 1, 6, and 11, the Energy Commission provided notice of the proposed changes to these regulations from that which were originally proposed to the following persons:

- (1) *Every person who testified at the public hearings held on March 12 and 13, 2012, on the originally proposed regulations;*

This notice was provided via email to the efficiency list serve and building standards list serve on May 15, 2012, and mailed to six mailing lists consisting of persons, agencies, companies, and organizations that have expressed interest in the building standards rulemaking process and also includes those persons or the groups those persons are associated with that testified at the public hearings held on March 12 and March 13.

- (2) *All persons who submitted written comments at that public hearing;*

This notice was provided via email to the efficiency list serve and building standards list serve on May 15, 2012 and mailed to six mailing lists consisting of persons, agencies, companies, and organizations that have expressed interest in the building standards rulemaking process and those persons who submitted written comments at the public hearings held on March 12 and March 13..

- (3) *All persons whose comments related to these regulations were received by the Energy Commission during the 45-day public comment period; and*

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the building standards rulemaking process and those persons who submitted written comments during the 45-day comment period.

- (4) *All persons who requested notification from the Energy Commission of the availability of such changes.*

All persons who requested notification from the Energy Commission of the availability of changes were directed to subscribe to the Energy Commission [which? Building Standards?] list-server. No persons objected to this form of notice. This was done in the manner normally and consistently used by the Energy Commission.

- (5) *The Secretary of the Resources Agency;*

This notice was provided via email on May 24, 2012.

- C. The notice and text of the proposed changes to these regulations from that which were originally proposed were made available at the Energy Commission and on its internet website on May 15, 2012.

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
