Energy Commission Staff Evaluation Report of CALCTP's Application to become a Lighting Controls ATTCP

The Energy Commission's 2013 Building Energy Efficiency Standards (Standards), Section 10-103-A(f), authorizes the Energy Commission to approve organizations to be a Lighting Controls Acceptance Test Technician Certification Provider (ATTCP). Additionally, pursuant to Section 10-103-A(f)(1) of the 2013 Standards, Energy Commission staff will review and validate all information received on ATTCP applications and determine whether the application is complete and meets the criteria specified in Section 10-103-A(c).

Section 10-103-A(f)2 requires the Energy Commission to give all interested persons a copy of the Evaluation Report used by Energy Commission staff in determining the application to be complete. Section 10-103-A(f)2 also requires the Energy Commission to give interested persons reasonable time to review the Evaluation Report and provide their comments prior to the Energy Commission's approval of the application.

This notice is to inform interested parties that the Energy Commission is posting the Evaluation Report used to review the California Advanced Lighting Controls Training Program (CALCTP) application to become a Lighting Controls ATTCP.

The Energy Commission will also be posting CALCTP's non-confidential application material used by Energy Commission staff to review CALCTP's application.
