TERMINATION**

On April 19, 2018, the City of Victorville submitted a letter requesting to terminate the Energy Commission license for the Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project.

Background

The Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project was certified by the Energy Commission on July 16, 2008 as a 563-megawatt (MW) hybrid facility consisting of up to 50 megawatts generated through solar trough technology. The facility would be located in the City of Victorville, in San Bernardino County.

On June 12, 2013, the Energy Commission approved a request for a 5-year extension to the start of construction deadline for the Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project, from July 16, 2013, to July 16, 2018. Construction on the project has not started.

Analysis

Staff reviewed the City of Victorville's letter requesting termination of the Victorville 2 project and has concluded that no construction activity on the project has taken place. Therefore, the requested termination would not result in any significant impacts on the environment, or to public health and safety, or result in any violation of laws, ordinances, regulations or standards.

Conclusion

Based on its analysis, Staff recommends the termination of the Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project certification.

On April 19, 2018, the City of Victorville submitted a letter to the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting to terminate the license for the Victorville 2 Power Project. The 563-megawatt (MW) hybrid (solar and natural gas) facility was certified by the Energy Commission in its Decision on July 16, 2008, and construction was never started. The facility was to be located in the City of Victorville, in San Bernardino County, California.

On June 12, 2013, the Energy Commission approved a request for a 5-year extension to the start of construction deadline for the Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project, from July 16, 2013, to July 16, 2018.

DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST TO TERMINATE

The request would terminate the Energy Commission license for the Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project, Docket No. 07-AFC-1C.

ENERGY COMMISSION REVIEW PROCEDURES

I. INTRODUCTION

On April 19, 2018, the City of Victorville submitted a letter requesting to terminate the Energy Commission certification for the Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project.

The Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project was certified by the Energy Commission on July 16, 2008 as a 563-megawatt (MW) hybrid facility consisting of up to 50 MW generated through solar trough technology. The facility would be located in the City of Victorville, in San Bernardino County. Construction has not begun on the approved project. On June 12, 2013, the Energy Commission approved a request for a 5-year extension to the start of construction deadline for the Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project, from July 16, 2013, to July 16, 2018.

II. STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Energy Commission staff reviewed the letter and recommends approval of the City of Victorville's request to terminate the Energy Commission certification for the Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project.

III. FINDINGS

Based on staff's review and recommendation, the Energy Commission concludes that the requested certification termination will not result in any significant impacts to public health and safety, or to the environment or result in any violation of laws, ordinances, regulations or standards.

IV. CONCLUSION AND ORDER

The California Energy Commission hereby adopts staff's recommendations and grants the request of the City of Victorville to terminate the Energy Commission certification of the Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project, effective June 30, 2018.
