ATTACHMENT A

SCOPE OF WORK

Description of Work:

DISTRICT shall provide Mitigation Trust funds to CONTRACTOR to augment their Clean Transportation Program funding for one or more subcontract(s) awarded to hydrogen refueling station developers under CONTRACTOR's light-duty hydrogen refueling station solicitation GFO-19-602 ("Grant Agreement").

Through this Contract, CONTRACTOR shall:

- Receive and administer Mitigation Trust funds for paying approved invoices for executed Grant Agreements for purchase and installation of hydrogen refueling stations.
- Use existing CEC grant funding practices and procedures to fund selected light-duty hydrogen refueling station equipment with partial funding from the Mitigation Trust funds.
- Oversee and manage Grant Agreement(s), using existing CEC grant funding practices and procedures, for the selected light-duty hydrogen fuel cell vehicle supply equipment receiving partial Mitigation Trust funding.

Tasks, Milestones, and Deliverables:

TASK 1- KICK-OFF MEETING

CONTRACTOR shall establish the lines of communication and procedures for implementing this Contract.

CONTRACTOR shall:

- Arrange a "kick-off" meeting with the DISTRICT, including scheduling the date and time. The CONTRACTOR shall include a contract administrator and others designated by the CONTRACTOR in this meeting. The administrative and technical aspects of this Contract will be discussed at the meeting.
- 2. Provide an agenda to all potential meeting participants prior to the kick-off meeting.

CONTRACTOR Deliverables:

1. Kick-off meeting agenda

TASK 2 – LOCATION AND FUNDING SELECTION

CONTRACTOR will select and fund light-duty hydrogen refueling station projects using existing CEC competitive solicitation practices and procedures. CONTRACTOR will work with DISTRICT to determine which projects to partially fund using Mitigation Trust funds to satisfy Mitigation Trust Requirements, which were developed based on the Consent Decree, State Trust Agreement, Agreement G18-VWM-03, the Beneficiary Mitigation Plan, and input received from stakeholder meetings.

CONTRACTOR shall:

- Provide a draft Notice of Proposed Awards (NOPA) from the CONTRACTOR's GFO-19-602 solicitation to DISTRICT so DISTRICT can determine which light-duty hydrogen refueling station projects will satisfy Mitigation Trust Requirements. Under this Contract, the CONTRACTOR is not required to fund grant applications it determines do not follow CONTRACTOR funding practices and procedures.
- 2. Assist DISTRICT in determining which light-duty hydrogen refueling station projects will satisfy Mitigation Trust Requirements by including data, such as fueling capacity for each station.

DISTRICT shall:

- 1. Provide the CONTRACTOR a list of all Mitigation Trust Requirements.
- 2. Identify any projects on the CONTRACTOR's draft NOPA described above that would be appropriate for Mitigation Trust funding under this Contract.
- 3. Seek and obtain appropriate approval to partially fund selected hydrogen refueling station projects using Mitigation Trust funds.
- 4. Provide written approval to the CONTRACTOR on which light-duty hydrogen refueling station projects are appropriate for Mitigation Trust funding.

CONTRACTOR Deliverables:

- 1. Draft NOPA, including the following information: dispensing pressure, whether station is publicly available, fueling capacity, and proximity to disadvantaged communities according to CalEnviroscreen.
- 2. After the NOPA is posted, copies of all passing applications including all supplemental documents submitted.

DISTRICT Deliverables:

- 1. List of all Mitigation Trust Requirements.
- 2. Draft list of stations proposed for award from the NOPA that would be appropriate for partial Mitigation Trust funding under this Contract.
- 3. Documentation of DISTRICT concurrence with the final list of stations to receive partial Mitigation Trust funding.

TASK 3 – GRANT AGREEMENT PROGRESS REPORTING

CONTRACTOR staff will hold a monthly briefing with the DISTRICT on the status of each grant agreement funded under GFO-19-602 that includes partial Mitigation Trust funding.

CONTRACTOR shall:

- Arrange briefing meetings with the DISTRICT, including scheduling the date and time. The CONTRACTOR shall include a contract administrator and others designated by the CONTRACTOR in this meeting. The status of each grant agreement funded under GFO-19-602 that includes partial Mitigation Trust funding will be discussed at the meeting.
- 2. Develop Grant Agreement(s) in accordance with CONTRACTOR and Mitigation Trust Requirements. All Grant Agreements shall include the requirements under Paragraph 11. Additional Provisions, such as Prevailing Wages, Equipment Ownership, and Audits.

3. Notify DISTRICT in writing, within 10 days, if any circumstances arise (technical, economic, or otherwise), which might place installation and a minimum of three-years of operation of the project in jeopardy.

DISTRICT shall:

1. Participate in monthly briefings with CONTRACTOR.

CONTRACTOR Deliverables:

- 1. Briefing meeting agendas.
- Notification in writing, within 10 days, if any circumstances arise (technical, economic, or otherwise), which might place installation and a minimum of three-years of operation of the project in jeopardy.

DISTRICT Deliverables:

1. Participation in monthly briefings with CONTRACTOR.

TASK 4 – INVOICING

CONTRACTOR will invoice and receive Mitigation Trust funds from DISTRICT for incurred Allowable Expenses in accordance with the CONTRACTOR's Grant Agreement(s).

CONTRACTOR shall:

- 1. Review invoices received from subcontractors for Grant Agreement(s) executed in Task 3.
- 2. Invoice DISTRICT for Mitigation Trust funds, as needed, but no more frequently than once per month, for Allowable Expenditures (defined in Attachment B) incurred by subcontractors under the Grant Agreement(s) executed in Task 3.
- 3. Reimburse subcontractors in accordance with the Prompt Payment Act (Government Code, Section 927, et seq.) for subcontractors incurred Allowable Expenditures.
- 4. Keep separate accounting of the Mitigation Trust funds received and expended.

DISTRICT shall:

- 1. Upon receipt of an invoice from the CONTRACTOR for incurred Allowable Expenditures incurred by subcontractors, remit funds to the CONTRACTOR in an amount equal to maximum percentage of Allowable Expenditures incurred by subcontractors under the Grant Agreement(s) executed in Task 3 (see Attachment B). Funds shall be remitted in a timely manner to support project completion and success and to ensure the CONTRACTOR complies with its duties under the Grant Agreement(s).

TASK 5 – PROGRESS REPORTING

CONTRACTOR staff shall provide copies of monthly progress reports submitted by CEC recipients funded with Mitigation Trust funds.

CONTRACTOR shall:

1. Provide copies of monthly progress reports submitted by CEC recipients funded with Mitigation Trust funds

CONTRACTOR Deliverables:

1. Copies of monthly progress reports submitted by CEC recipients.

TASK 6 – RECORD RETENTION

CONTRACTOR shall retain records related to the Grant Agreement(s) that is identified in Task 2, including those funded with Mitigation Trust funds.

CONTRACTOR shall:

- 1. Store all records in accordance with accepted State of California procedures to maintain safety, security, and confidentiality.
- 2. Retain files for the term of this Contract plus three years.

CONTRACTOR Deliverables:

1. Upon request, submit copies of all project records to DISTRICT. Hardcopy or electronic records are suitable. DISTRICT shall identify acceptable forms of electronic media.

COST SCHEDULE

Costs:

DISTRICT shall reimburse CONTRACTOR for Allowable Expenditures incurred under the Grant Agreement(s) executed in Task 3 in an amount equal to maximum percentage of Allowable Expenditures incurred by subcontractors under the Grant Agreement(s) executed in Task 3, as listed below.

- 33 percent of Allowable Expenditures for equipment capable of dispensing at least 250 kg/day.
- 25 percent of Allowable Expenditures for equipment capable of dispensing at least 100 kg/day.
- At least 20% of total awarded Mitigation Trust funding must be awarded to projects in or benefiting disadvantaged or low-income communities.

No administrative support funding is available from CARB, DISTRICT, or the Mitigation Trust for expenditures incurred by the CONTRACTOR for work related to Mitigation Trust funds.

Up to \$1 million Mitigation Trust funding under this Contract may be reallocated to another contractor at DISTRICT's discretion, so long as those Mitigation Trust funds have not already been spent or encumbered.
