

**Section 2: Describe the entity's business activity or its nature and interests.**

The Los Angeles Cleantech Incubator (LACI) is a private non-profit organization creating an inclusive green economy by unlocking innovation, transforming markets, and enhancing communities. Founded as an economic development initiative by the City of Los Angeles and its Department of Water and Power, LACI is recognized as one of the most innovative business incubators in the world. In the past six years, LACI has helped 73 portfolio companies raise funding, revenue, and create jobs.

**Section 3.2: Specific description of the payment and its agency purpose and use.**

Linda Barrera, Advisor to Vice Chair Janea Scott at the California Energy Commission (CEC) participated at the Transportation Electrification Partnership Advisory Group Meeting in Los Angeles, CA on March 29, 2019. The Partnership, formed by LACI in May 2018, is an unprecedented multi-year partnership among local, regional, and state stakeholders to accelerate progress towards transportation electrification and zero emissions goods movement in the greater Los Angeles region.

This meeting provided an opportunity for discussion and review of the Partnership's goal of reducing statewide greenhouse gas emissions and improving the regional air quality. Also, Linda spoke regarding the CEC's priorities and updates on transportation electrification. The meeting was a collaboration of other government representatives, key regulators, and main utility representatives.
