ClimateWorks Foundation, established in 2008, is a team of researchers, strategists, collaborators, and grant-makers who are committed to climate action and believe in the power of collective philanthropy. The Foundation has given hundreds of grants worldwide, helped build greater capacity in key regions, and collaborated with a network of partners to support research, policy advocacy, outreach and public engagement, all with the aim of reducing the emissions that cause climate change.

**Section 3.2: Specific description of the payment and its agency purpose and use.**

Janea A. Scott, a Commissioner at the California Energy Commission, participated in "2050 Today" in San Francisco, California on June 13-15, 2018. "2050 Today" was a strategy meeting designed to provide input on ClimateWorks' *2050 Philanthropic Priorities for Climate Action*. The meeting covered a range of topics related to deep decarbonization, electrification, carbon removal/carbon sinks, innovation, and the transitions needed to achieve net-zero emissions globally by mid-century. Commissioner Scott was also a panel speaker during the meeting: "Tipping the Scales: Identifying global tipping points for policy and technology adoption".

This meeting provided a valuable opportunity for Commissioner Scott, as a California energy leader, to collaborate with others including experts, partners, and funders, all working together on 2050 strategies and outcomes.
