Section 2: Describe the entity's business activity or its nature and interests.

The Western Interstate Energy Board is an organization of 11 Western States and three western Canadian Provinces. The legal basis of the Energy Board is the Western Interstate Nuclear Compact (Public Law 91-461). The governor of each state and the premier of each province appoints a member to the Board. The purpose of the Board is to provide the instruments and framework for cooperative state efforts to enhance the economy of the West. The Board seeks to achieve this purpose by promoting energy policy that is developed cooperatively among member states and with the federal government.

Section 3.2: Specific description of the payment and its agency purpose and use.

Janea A. Scott, Vice Chair at the California Energy Commission (CEC) and Linda Barrera, Advisor to Vice Chair Scott, will participate at the joint Western Interconnection Regional Advisory Board (WIRAB) and the Committee on Regional Electric Power Cooperation (CREPC) meeting in San Diego, California.

The joint WIRAB/CREPC meeting provides a valuable opportunity for California energy leaders to provide California's perspective on western interconnection issues. As the WIRAB Chair, Vice Chair Scott will take an active, leading role in shaping the discussion around important issues such as integrating increased levels of renewable energy into the western interconnect, planning for new infrastructure and resource adequacy, and identifying west-wide energy challenges. California needs a strong and present voice during these meetings, thus it is critical that Vice Chair Scott participate in person at the joint WIRAB/CREPC meeting.

Vice Chair Scott's and Linda Barrera's participation will ensure that California's perspective is well represented in these discussions.
