California Clean Energy Fund dba CalCEF Ventures. Proposed resolution approving a scope of work change to Icarus RT, Inc.'s California Sustainable Energy Entrepreneur Development (CalSEED) Initiative small grant award, previously approved at the February 10, 2021 CEC Business Meeting; and adopting staff's determination that this action is exempt from CEQA. CalCEF Ventures administers the CEC's CalSEED Initiative under Agreement 300-15-007. Icarus RT, Inc. originally received a small grant to demonstrate a 100kW system that cools photovoltaic panels to increase performance and uses that heat to generate energy. After significant customer discovery and market research, Icarus RT, Inc. proposes to instead demonstrate that same technology with a 25kW system and a 50kW system that uses the heat from the cooled panels to pre-heat hot water. RESOLUTION - RE: CALIFORNIA CLEAN ENERGY FUND DBA CALCEF VENTURES

WHEREAS, the State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission ("CEC") has created the California Sustainable Energy Entrepreneur Development ("CalSEED") Initiative within the Electric Program Investment Charge ("EPIC") Program to provide funding for public interest research, development and demonstration activities; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the CEC approves a scope of work change to Icarus RT, Inc.'s CalSEED small grant award for the project titled "Hybrid Photovoltaic/Thermal (PVT) Advanced Solar Plus Storage System" to change the project from a demonstration of a 100 kW system that cools photovoltaic panels to increase performance and uses that heat to generate energy to a demonstration of that same technology with a 25 kW system and a 50 kW system that uses the heat from the cooled panels to pre-heat hot water; and

**FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED**, that the CEC directs CalCEF Ventures to execute the same on behalf of the CEC.
