Alana will attend the low to moderate income Clean Energy Group/Clean Energy States Alliance solar workshop on behalf of the State of California on 6/13/17 in Washington, DC. This workshop, only open to state employees, will examine the challenges states face in promoting low to moderate income solar and will highlight ideas for overcoming those challenges. Alana will learn about financing, using community solar to advance solar for low to moderate income households, low to moderate income solar with storage as a strategy to reduce lifecycle costs, and harnessing existing poverty and housing programs for solar. This information will be beneficial to the Energy Commission as it implements SB 350 and its recommendations from the Low-Income Barriers Study.
