The U.S.-China Clean Tech Center, which has locations in Los Angeles and Beijing, hosted the U.S.-China Clean Tech Summit in Guangdong. The UCCTC reached out to Chair Weisenmiller to speak at the event about California's clean energy goals, clean energy economy, and opportunities for global cooperation.

Section 3.2: Payment Description

By attending the U.S.-China Clean Tech Summit, Chair Weisenmiller helped advance the California-China Clean Technology Partnership (CCCTP), which was established by Governor Brown in June 2017.
