## Section 2: Describe the entity's business activity or its nature and interests.

The Center works directly with governors, legislators, regulators, companies, and stakeholders by providing technical and strategic assistance to help decision makers create policies that facilitate America's transition to a clean energy economy.

## Section 3.2: Specific description of the payment and its agency purpose and use.

Matt Coldwell, Advisor to Commissioner Janea A. Scott at the California Energy Commission, participated at the Center for the New Energy Economy's (CNEE) *Repowering the Western Economy* meeting in Denver, Colorado. CNEE has been facilitating a multi-state dialogue to identify the key challenges facing the electricity sector in the West and how to address those challenges through enhanced regional coordination and state policy.

CNEE's Repowering the Western Economy meeting provides a valuable opportunity for California energy leaders to provide California's perspective on western energy planning issues. The Chair of the Energy Commission and Commissioner Scott requested Matt Coldwell to attend on their behalf to provide California's perspective on important issues such as trends, challenges, and opportunities to the west's changing generation mix, electrifying the transportation sector, integrating increased levels of renewable energy into the western interconnect, planning for new infrastructure and resource adequacy, and identifying west-wide energy challenges.
