Section 2: Describe the entity's business activity or its nature and interests.

Agora Verkehrswende is the German partner of the Institute of Transportation Studies – UC Davis. Agora is a joint initiative of the Stiftung Mercator Foundation and the European Climate Foundation with the objective to deliver debates, scenarios, and strategies for decarbonizing the German transport sector by 2050.

The Norwegian Electric Vehicle Association is a non-profit organization, and is a member of The European Association for Electromobility and the World Electric Vehicle Association. For more than 20 years, the Norwegian EV Association has been working for the successful introduction of electric vehicles. Their main goal is to promote electric vehicles that run fully or partially on renewable energy.

Section 3.2: Specific description of the payment and its agency purpose and use.

Janea A. Scott, a Commissioner at the California Energy Commission (CEC), gave a key note presentation and spoke on a panel at *DE.CA.rbonize Transportation: The German-Californian Conference on Zero Emission Transportation*, in Berlin, Germany. The conference focused on accelerating the transformation and decarbonization of transportation – a critical component to meeting the greenhouse gas emissions goals for both Germany and California. Commissioner Scott had the opportunity to engage with policy leaders to discuss the political, economic, technological, and societal opportunities and challenges associated with transforming their respective transportation sectors.

Commissioner Scott also spoke on a panel at the *Nordic EV Summit* in Oslo, Norway. The summit gathered policymakers from national and local authorities in the Nordic countries and beyond to discuss the local and global state of the EV industry, the role of emerging market trends such as autonomous vehicles, car sharing services, and mobility on demand. She also met with multiple key Norwegian government officials to discuss zero emission transportation.

As the Lead Commissioner on Transportation at the CEC, Commissioner Scott brought valuable insight to our German and Nordic partners, and was also able to learn directly about the clean transportation policies and programs being implemented throughout Europe.
