#### PURPOSE:

The state and the Energy Commission have placed a high priority on maintaining reliability of the electric system for over four decades. One component of implementing this priority is active participation in the affairs of the Western Interconnection (WI) and various regional entities that exist in the west. Among the most important of these for reliability are WECC (Western Electricity Coordinating Council), and WIRAB (Western Interconnection Reliability Advisory Body). In 2012, the Commission approved Grace Anderson's participation as a western state (Class 5) Member Representative, serving on the WECC Member Advisory Committee (MAC). The purpose of this trip is for Grace to fulfill her responsibilities as a voting member of the MAC by participating in WECC's first quarter Board and Member Advisory Committee meetings requiring travel March 8-11, 2020 in Salt Lake, UT. A high priority for WIRAB, WECC will be kicking off its 2021 strategic planning and budgeting processes.

#### SOURCE OF FUNDING:

The Western Interconnection Reliability Advisory body (WIRAB) provides funding for Class 5 MAC Members to attend quarterly meetings of WECC and the MAC. This trip is no-cost to the state.
