
Mass-Market Demand Flexibility through Responsive Automation

### Joint Parties' Request and Staff Evaluation

Current MIDAS Upload Deadline: July 1, 2023

Requested Extension: April 1, 2024 (9-month delay)



#### **Issues and Initial CEC Proposed Order**

	Issue Raised	Initial CEC Proposed Order
1	CCAs - generation	CCAs & IOUs upload their portions by August 1, 2023
	IOUs - transmission & distribution	
2	Rate modifiers	Affected rates to be uploaded by October 1, 2023

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#### **Amended CEC Proposed Order**

- 1. Allow an extra month for base rate uploads (August 1, 2023) with minor clarifications
- 2. Allow three extra months for rates with modifiers (October 1, 2023)
- 3. San Diego Gas & Electric: Allow nine extra months for two specific hourly rates that require automation development (April 1, 2024)
