
Mass-Market Demand Flexibility through Responsive Automation

Joint Parties' Request and Staff Evaluation

Current MIDAS Upload Deadline: July 1, 2023

Requested Extension: April 1, 2024 (9-month delay)



Issues and Initial CEC Proposed Order

	Issue Raised	Initial CEC Proposed Order
1	CCAs - generation IOUs - transmission & distribution	CCAs & IOUs upload their portions by August 1, 2023
2	Rate modifiers	Affected rates to be uploaded by October 1, 2023



Amended CEC Proposed Order

1. Allow an extra month for base rate uploads (August 1, 2023) with minor clarifications
2. Allow three extra months for rates with modifiers (October 1, 2023)
3. San Diego Gas & Electric: Allow nine extra months for two specific hourly rates that require automation development (April 1, 2024)
