Background

2020 - AB 1657 established LVC

2021 - LVC initiates meetings and work

2022 - LVC submits with 15 recommendations

2023 - CEC focuses on learning:

- Conducts tour and visit for DOE
- Brings state representatives to meet tribal and local government leaders
- Attends educational sessions with CBOs
- Initiates coordination among state agencies
