Overview

- Block grant for medium- and heavy-duty (MDHD) zero-emission vehicle (ZEV) infrastructure incentive projects
- \$276 million in current spending authority approved in December 2021
- \$269 million proposed for a total contingent spending authority of \$544 million

Benefit to Californians

Enables:

- Accessible MDHD electric charging and hydrogen refueling
- Progress converting all MDHD vehicles to zero-emission
- Targeted emission reductions and health benefits





Project Overview

- **Energy Infrastructure Incentives for Zero-Emission Commercial Vehicles (EnergIIZE)**
- Four foundational funding lanes
- Set-Aside funding lanes to compliment awardees of CARB's Hybrid and Zero-Emission Truck and Bus Voucher Incentive Project (HVIP)





EnergiZE Quick Stats

- 443 applications reviewed
- 185 awards
- \$106M incentives awarded
- \$95.4M incentives for disadvantaged and/or low-income communities
- 2,178 MDHD chargers & 45 H2 dispensers
- 2,683 EVs & 822 FCEVs supported
