

California Energy Commission Chair Robert B. Weisenmiller has been invited to participate in the ZEIT KONFERENZ Energie & Klimaschutz (Energy & Climate Change) in Berlin, Germany on September 4th. The conference organizer, CONVENT, will cover the cost of travel to and from Berlin, as well as two nights lodging. Additionally, they will cover the cost of the shuttle from the airport to the hotel and back, as well as the cost of transportation from the hotel to the conference location. The California Energy Commission will need to pay for the additional night of lodging.

CONVENT, on behalf of Germany's leading weekly newspaper DIE ZEIT, has invited the Chair to participate in a high-ranking panel that will discuss the strategies and decisions needed to speed up the energy transition.

Under the leadership of Governor Brown, Chair Weisenmiller has taken on a prominent role as an international leader, sharing California energy policy and helping to lead the transition to low-carbon energy resources and the fight against climate change. Given his role and experience, the Chair is uniquely suited to represent California at this event. His attendance and participation at ZEIT KONFERENZ Energie & Klimaschutz will broaden cooperation and engagement between California and the international community and will signify California's continued leadership and commitment to work with our neighbors near and far to fight a global problem. Further, his participation will allow the Chair to reach a global audience in advance of upcoming international events, including the California-Germany Bilateral Energy Conference and the Global Climate Action Summit in San Francisco.
