RESOLUTION: Aspen Environmental Group

RESOLVED, that the State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission (CEC) adopts the staff CEQA findings contained in the Agreement or Amendment Request Form (as applicable); and

RESOLVED, that the CEC approves an amendment to Agreement 300-22-003 with Aspen Environmental Group. This amendment is for: (1) \$2,000,000 budget augmentation, (2) two-year term extension, (3) amending budget reallocation terms and conditions, and (4) increasing labor rate of one subcontractor. This amendment will support the following areas: (1) non-lithium long duration energy storage (NLLDES) grants; (2) U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) applications for NLLDES grants; and (3) other technical support, including CEQA review. Staff recommends conditional approval of this item based upon funding availability as of the 2024 Budget Act; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Director or their designee shall execute the same on behalf of the CEC.

Proposed resolution approving an amendment to Agreement 300-22-300 with Aspen Environmental Group, and adopting staff's determination that this action is exempt from CEQA. This amendment is for: (1) a \$2,000,000 budget augmentation, (2) a two-year term

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extension, (3) amending the contract terms and conditions to allow budget reallocations via CAM and supervisor approval, and (4) increasing the labor rate of one subcontractor. This amendment will provide technical support to the CEC in three areas: (1) preparing and issuing grants for the development of non-lithium long duration energy storage (NLLDES) projects; (2) preparing grant applications seeking to obtain Department of Energy (DOE) grants to fund additional NLLDES projects; and (3) preparing miscellaneous technical studies, assessments (including CEQA review and assessments), and providing other support services in connection with NLLDES. Here the project involves preliminary activities such as providing reviews of LDES projects, preparing technology assessment reports, and supporting the preparation, evaluation, and management of grant funding opportunities. The project also includes preparation of US Department of Energy applications and preparation of other miscellaneous support studies. The project does not involve any physical impacts since all work will be conducted on computers. Agreement tasks do include providing preliminary CEQA project assessments and environmental impact analyses for potential future NLLDES projects, but the project does not commit to funding any of the recommendations flowing from the agreement. Any potential locations of future storage would require compliance with CEQA before the CEC could fund said future projects.

The project meets the Categorical Exemption 14 CCR 15306 in that all activities consist of basic data collection, research, and resource evaluation activities and do not result in a serious or major disturbance to an environmental resource.

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This project consists of information gathering, report preparation, and other computer-based technical support for the LDES program leading to actions which a public agency has not yet approved, adopted or funded. This project does not involve impacts on any particularly sensitive environment; does not involve any cumulative impacts of successive projects of the same type in the same place that might be considered significant; does not involve unusual circumstances that might have a significant effect on the environment; will not result in damage to scenic resources within a highway officially designated as a state scenic highway; the project site is not included on any list compiled pursuant to Government Code section 65962.5; and the project will not cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historical resource. Therefore, none of the exceptions to categorical exemptions listed in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 apply to this project and this project will not have a significant effect on the environment.

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA.
